An audit of the agency LPR system, FLOCK, was conducted on Monday January 15th, 2024 in accordance with General Order 2022-01, License Plate Readers.

As of December 31, 2023, 100 LPR cameras are being managed by the Lexington Police Department.

A review of the monthly usage produced the below data:

October 2023

- 208 Users conducted a Search in the System
- 5801 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
- 869 Unique reasons were searched

November 2023

- 218 Users conducted a search in the system
- 5671 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
- 938 Unique incidents or cases searched

December 2023

- 196 Users conducted a search in the system
- 5082 Total searches were conducted and all listed a reason for the search
- 1021 Unique incidents or cases searched

A review of the 2828 unique search reasons for the quarter indicated that (5) five (0.17%) did not provide enough detail about the reason for the search. Additional audit review into the (5) five searches yielded that all were legitimate investigative searches. The tag searched was also searched by other Officers on the call who did list the case number and reason for the search. A list of users with insufficient search reason field data is being compiled for future audits. Contact was made with the Officers Supervisor in these 5 searches for additional policy review to be conducted and to ensure compliance with future searches within the system. Repeated compliance issues may warrant further action that may involve re-training, counseling, discipline, and/or system access restriction.
