Continued non-compliance after the above indicated "Compliance Due Date" may result in additional citations being issued until compliance is gained. If the property owner does not bring the property into compliance the violations may be abated/corrected by governmental operations and all abatement costs and related administrative fees will be invoiced to the property owner.

How to Appeal a Citation

- 1. The permittee shall comply with Section 16-104 of Article X of Chapter 16 of LFUCG's Code of Ordinances and this permit.
- Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee from the responsibility of obtaining any other permits or licenses required by the Urban County Government or other state or federal agencies.
- 3. The permittee shall implement the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan submitted to and accepted by the LFUCG Division of Engineering (DOE), pursuant to Section 16-102 of Article X of Chapter 16 of LFUCG's Code of Ordinances. The permittee shall modify the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan as necessary during construction to minimize impacts to stormwater runoff.
- 4. The permittee shall conduct soil stabilization in any area within 14 days after land disturbing activities have permanently or temporarily ceased. Soil stabilization shall be generally be defined as a uniform vegetative cover with a density of at least 70%.
- 5. The permittee shall protect curb and surface inlets from sediment.
- 6. The permittee shall maintain construction entrances to prevent tracking of mud onto public streets.
- 7. The permittee shall submit a Notice of Termination to DOE when final stabilization has been achieved. Final soil stabilization shall be generally defined as a uniform perennial vegetative cover with a density of at least 70%.
- 8. A copy of this permit shall be posted at the job site.
- 9. Noncompliance with this permit shall subject the permittee to enforcement actions pursuant to Article XII of Chapter 16 of LFUCG's Code of Ordinances.

10. Builder Responsibilities as outlined in the LFUCG Procedures Manual apply.
