1. That on or about the above ACTION DATE, the Affiant, acting on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG"), and pursuant to KRS 65.8801, et seq.; and Article 5 of LFUCG'S Zoning Ordinance, issued a citation with a civil fine in the amount of ACTION COST which includes any applicable administrative fee, against OWNER for the condition of real property located at

- 2.
